Electronics, Handcrafted Items, etc.

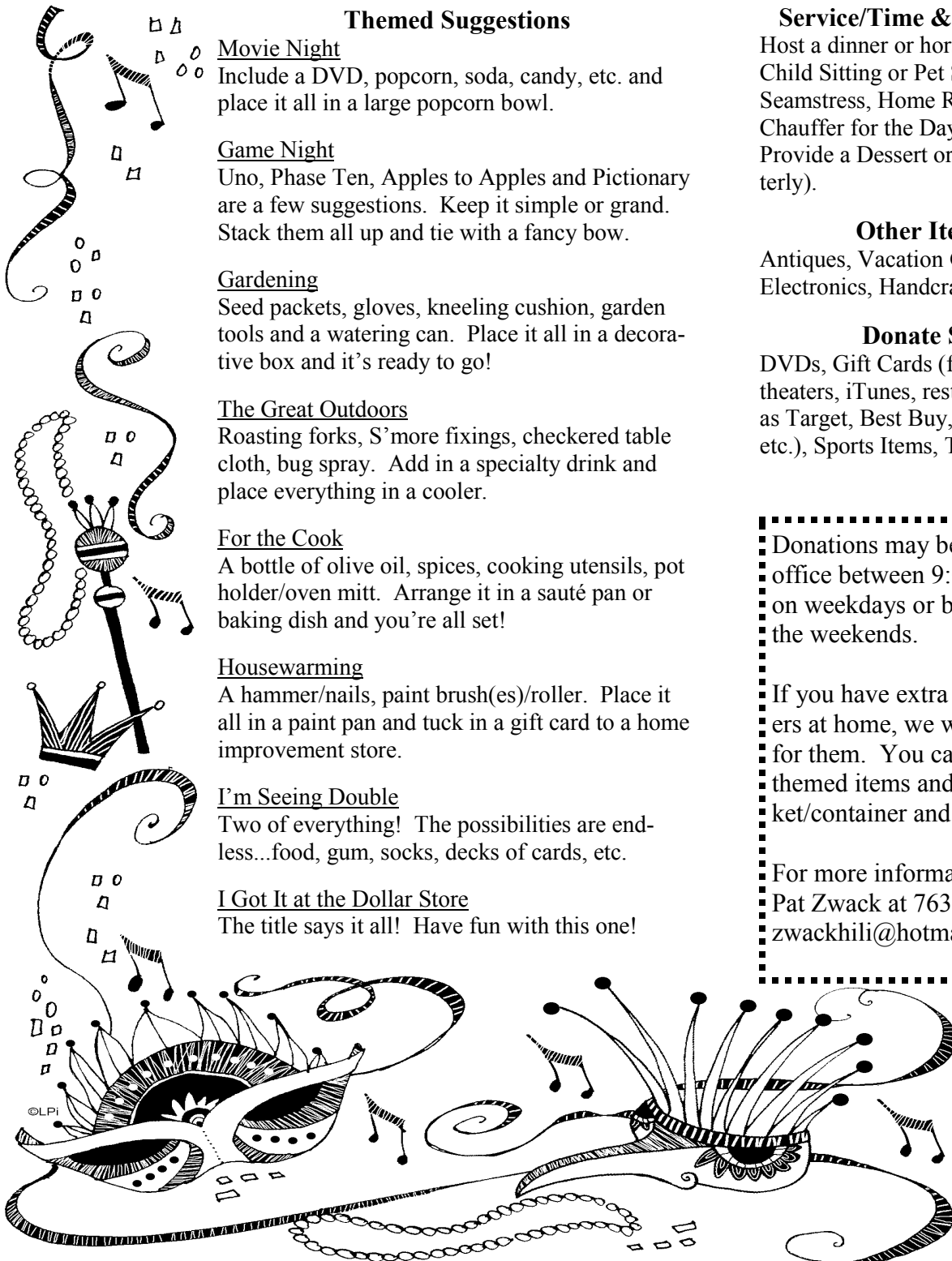
## Donate Single Items
